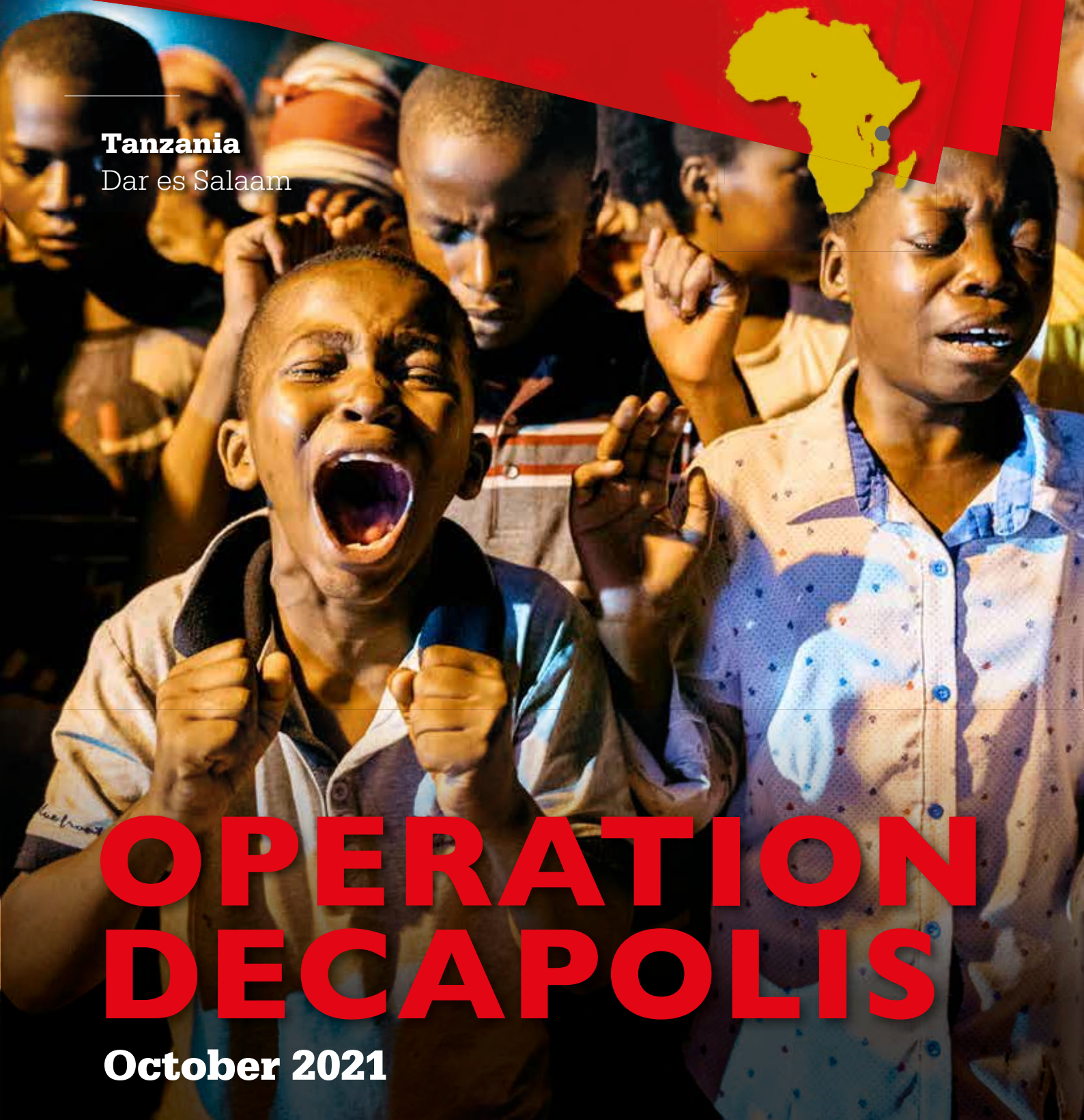

30 Gospel Campaign events in 5 days!

Once again, a new high-water mark has been reached. In our October “Operation Decapolis”, we held six CfaN Gospel Campaigns in six areas of Dar es Salaam, lasting five nights each. That’s thirty nights of campaign meetings – in less than a week!

In this crowded, sprawling metropolis, it can take two hours or more to travel just a few kilometers. With the Operation Decapolis strategy the Lord gave us, anyone in the city was within easy reach of a Gospel Campaign. In addition, we conducted two weeks of “Gospel Invasion” leading up to the campaigns, where Bootcamp graduates did hundreds of outreaches in the area. In all, we documented 210,553 decisions for Christ here in Dar es Salaam!

OPERATION
Decapolis

The word “**Decapolis**” means “**ten cities**” in Greek (“*deka*” = ten, “*poleis*” = cities). In the time of Christ, “*Decapolis*” was a specific (mostly gentile) region in which Jesus performed some of his great miracles. We have appropriated this word because it perfectly describes a vision the Lord has given us of exponential

increase, from one campaign per week to ten.

Last year we made our first attempt at this multi-campaign strategy. In the middle of our preparations, the pandemic brought the world to a standstill. Nevertheless, we successfully held our first multi-campaign event in five cities (three campaigns in week one, two campaigns in week two). In June of this year, we had our second attempt, where we conducted five campaigns in five cities in one week. This time, we’ve scaled up to six campaigns in one week. Next time we will conduct ten campaigns in ten cities over two weeks, five in week one and five in week two. The next step will be conducting all ten in one week. Then we will scale up as much as possible, conducting multiple Decapolis Campaigns per year.

Soon we will be conducting 20, 30, and 40 campaigns (and more) per year! It is a process,

but with each attempt, we are making huge leaps forward – even during great turmoil in the world. And it’s not just quantity - it’s quality. Converts are being ushered into local churches, believers are being trained in evangelism, and unparalleled unity between the churches is being forged. Here are just a few of the many testimonies we received, shared by the guest evangelists who preached and ministered in each area.

Dar es Salaam – **Kimara**

Evangelist Daniel Kolenda preached one night of every campaign, starting in Kimara. For the other four nights in each area, two guest evangelists (most of them Bootcamp graduates) preached and prayed for the sick. In Kimara – where there has never been a Gospel Campaign before – it was Evangelists Denis Artyushevskiy and Evelina Smane who brought the Good News.

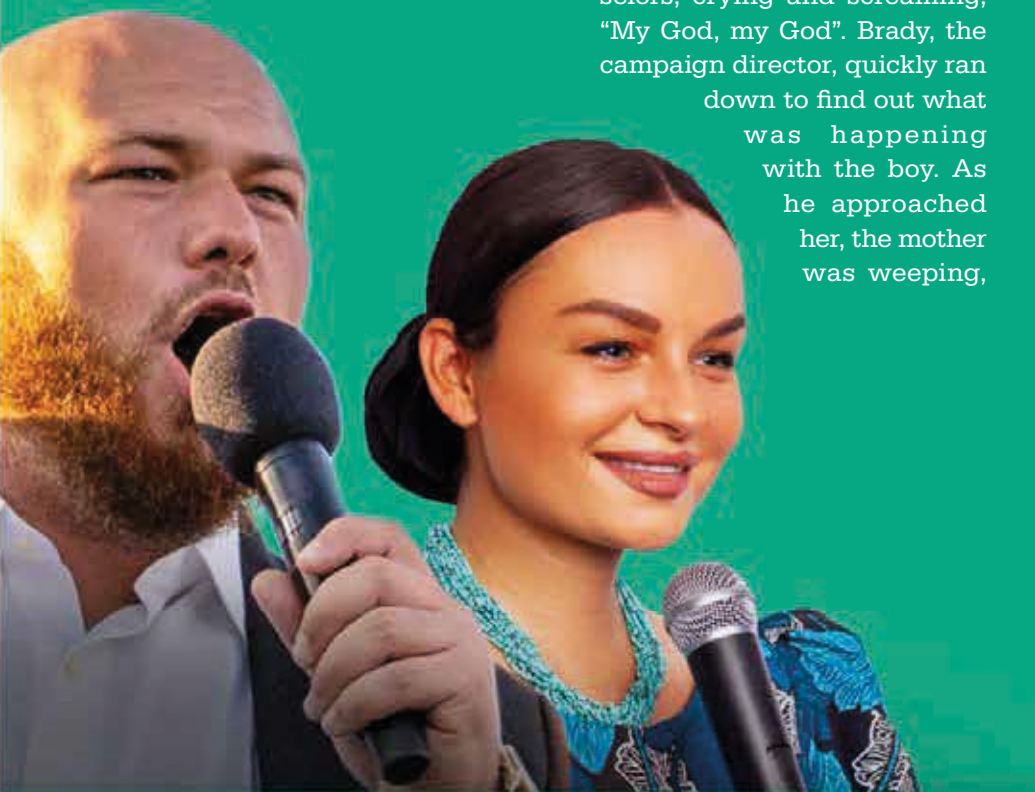
We celebrated as we lit barrels full of witchcraft items, breaking every demonic curse. Many people were delivered. The following day, others brought bags full of witchcraft charms, despite being told by witchdoctors that the moment they took the charms off, they would die. There was great liberation and after we broke the curses, we prayed for the sick.

The first testimony is one I will never forget for the rest of our lives. I saw a mother walking with one of the counselors, crying and screaming, “My God, my God”. Brady, the campaign director, quickly ran down to find out what was happening with the boy. As he approached her, the mother was weeping,



saying that since he was five, he was unable to move or walk. As I prayed, the boy began moving to the sound of the worship music that was taking place. As we went on stage, I asked the boy to try to get out of his wheelchair. The crowd went silent, and you could only hear the noise of the generator and a slight breeze from the wind. The boy started moving back and forth, sliding down to place his feet on the ground. He used his hands to brace himself as he stood up, and the crowd began to roar. His mother moved the wheelchair away, and I asked the boy to walk towards me. He began taking small steps, without any assistance. The band and crowd began worshiping and chanting the name of Jesus as the boy then walked to the other side of the stage and began dancing.

Gongo La Mboto

Evangelists Lukas Repert and Daniel Garcia (both Bootcamp graduates) described the campaign in Gongo La Mboto as a “festival of miracles”.

The most holy moment of the night was the call for salvation. As the invitation was given to receive salvation through Jesus Christ, people repented by the thousands. Former Muslims across the field filled out decision cards to get connected with local churches. It was their day of salvation!

Then I prayed to break the spirit of infirmity. I did not even have a chance to call people forward to testify. They were already running to the stage to proclaim what Jesus had done. A powerful testimony came from a woman who was deaf

in both ears for ten years. She came to the campaign wearing hearing aids, unable to hear at all. Then, when I prayed for deaf ears to be opened, she felt something happen in her ears. I tested her hearing on stage without the hearing aids and rejoiced with her over her complete healing.

Another lady had not been able to walk for six years. She came on stage partially healed. Daniel Garcia prayed for her, and she received her full healing right there on the platform in front of everyone's eyes! She danced and began



to praise Jesus. And a beautiful little boy testified that he was blind for 11 years. He recovered his sight and chased Daniel all over the stage as the crowd praised Jesus. His mom was so thrilled that her little boy would be able to run, see, and live differently for the rest of his life.

Jangwani

Evangelists Jim and Kathy Leamon and Evangelist Jacob Ebersole were stationed in the district of Jangwani, where Evangelist Daniel Kolenda joined them to preach on the third night of Operation Decapolis.

On night two, someone began to walk across the field in front of the stage carrying his own crutches. The crowd roared with awe and wonder, the sound of freedom! He came on stage and testified that he had a car accident 10 years ago, leaving him with a spinal cord injury. He couldn't

walk or stand without assistance, and walking was difficult, even with crutches. During prayer, he felt the power of God on him and then strength poured into his legs. He stood up from his chair and began to walk without any help and without his crutches.

To preach at all six campaigns in five days, Daniel Kolenda had to preach at two events on the fourth night – another first for CfaN. The first of these was Kigamboni, where Evangelists Joe Turnbull and Randy Roberts were ministering. Evangelist Roberts shared this story.

Right before I began to preach on the second night, I had a brief conversation with Kai-Uwe Bonnke, and asked him how he stayed faithful after so many years serving the ministry his father started decades ago. His answer surprised me. He said that some years back, CfaN started to do testimony videos of what God was doing during

these massive gatherings. While filming these testimonies, he began to see how individual lives were being transformed by God as his father and Evangelist Daniel Kolenda preached the simple Gospel. So now he doesn't see the huge crowd, but each and every individual. I believe this is how our Father in heaven sees it as well. This was foremost in my mind as I interviewed one precious

older woman. She had suffered from rheumatoid arthritis for years and was unable to do the simplest of tasks or even walk properly. We wept together as we thanked our mighty King Jesus for what He had done. No more shuffling to the market, no more discouragement because she couldn't cook a simple meal for her family and no more unfulfilled desires to pick up her grandchildren. Mbagala

Mbagala was the second campaign Evangelist Daniel Kolenda preached at that night. On the ground for the whole event were Evangelists Rob Enge and Roselyne Ayeola. Rob Enge is Daniel Kolenda's Executive Assistant, and he's also an evangelist. This was the first time he preached at a CfaN campaign.

Before arriving in the city of Mbagala, I received updates from our Campaign Director of the challenges they faced there. The churches had never been able to host such a gathering due to another dominant religion in the region. Permits were never granted. Access to meeting locations was always denied. But our CfaN and Decapolis Team pressed onward in faith, and the favor of the Lord was with us. Our permits were approved, and the venue was released for use. At the field dedication, where

bishops, pastors and local partnering churches gather to pray for the campaign before it starts, a witch came to see what was happening. As the power of God was moving, she fell to her knees. One of the pastors prayed for her and she accepted Jesus Christ as her Lord and Savior! She immediately turned over all the witchcraft items she had brought. History was being made, even before a word was spoken from the platform.

On night four, after Evangelist Kolenda preached a crystal-clear Gospel message, with thousands surrendering their lives to Jesus, he asked me to

pray for the people to receive the Baptism of the Holy Spirit. As the Executive Assistant to Evangelist Kolenda for seven years, I've seen him usher multitudes into the presence of Jesus. Now, he was allowing me the privilege. As I witnessed him do so many times, I told the people to fix their eyes on Jesus and open their hearts to receive this free gift. All over the field, thousands began to receive the Holy Spirit with the evidence of new tongues. Even the young people in attendance were being filled with the Holy Spirit. This image is seared into my heart and will serve as a constant reminder that there is no junior Holy Spirit.

Dar es Salaam –

Kawe

Evangelists Levi Lutz and Macoby Donaldson each preached two nights in Kawe. For Macoby Donaldson, it was the first time he had ever preached at a campaign.

Throughout my preparation, I had two comforting thoughts, one practical and one spiritual. The first truth – I was trained for practical campaign ministry at the CfaN Evangelism Bootcamp. I was trained by the best of the best for this specific purpose. The second truth – I know that God is sovereign. He is God, whether or not I am the most eloquent, powerful or anointed preacher on the field. If I am faithful to preach with faith in Jesus and not faith in myself, He will show up, save souls, and confirm the Word of God.

On the first night, I walked up to pray for the sick after Levi Lutz finished preaching and I gave it everything I have. I did exactly as I learned in Bootcamp and to my utter surprise, it worked! Many hundreds of people were healed. One woman was brought onto the platform on a stretcher. Her daughter said she couldn't walk because her feet were damaged. As I watched them bring her onstage, I did have feelings of worry. But what came strongly after that was belief and faith that God is so good, and the Word of God is true. We prayed for her right there in front of tens of

thousands of people. After we prayed, they helped her up and she walked. She smiled as she took our hands, took her first steps in several years – and she walked off that platform on her own two feet! Then we heard from a man who had a stroke and couldn't move the left side of his body. He told us how he went from doctor to doctor looking for treatment, having many operations, but nothing helped him. But after we prayed, when I asked the crowd to test their bodies, he said suddenly he could begin to feel his left side. Then life returned to his left arm, and he began to take steps without his stick on his left side. He hadn't done that in three years since the stroke. He was truly thrilled and thanked Jesus publicly for healing his body when the doctors couldn't.
