## 273 OUTREACHES IN 7 WEEKS

Seven weeks before the start of the CfaN Gospel Campaign in Abeokuta, Nigeria, we sent a team of evangelists to begin bombarding the region with the Gospel. Two-by-two, they went anywhere and everywhere that we could get permission to hold an outreach. **Schools, markets, jails and hospitals became fertile ground for the Good News.**

The weather in Nigeria is hot and humid, the conditions tiring, to say the least. But that didn't stop these committed teams from preaching, over and over again. In the seven weeks, they conducted an astonishing 273 outreaches. **That's an average of 39 outreaches every week!** It was an immense labor of love, with a glorious result. Before the main campaign had started, we recorded 77,879 decisions for Jesus.

It's tremendously exciting for us to see the **Decade of Double Harvest** strategies bearing such rich fruit. Each one of those people is now being followed up by a local church.



## "I COME REPRESENTING THE KING OF KINGS!"

Anticipation in the Abeokuta area was high when Evangelist Daniel Kolenda, Reverend Peter Vandenberg and the team arrived for the Gospel Campaign. They were greeted on the side of the road by a lively crowd of local believers, pastors, bishops and other leaders. The team

was then whisked away to the governor's mansion, where the governor (a believer) had invited Daniel to share the Gospel with the entire cabinet.

Straight after that, Daniel was taken to the local king's palace, where he once again shared the Gospel. **He**

told the king that he came representing another king – not just any king – but the **King of Kings and the Lord of Lords**. Right there and then, in the courtroom of the palace, Daniel led some of the chiefs to Jesus.



## TODAY, THE DAY OF PENTECOST HAS FULLY COME

In the Fire Conference on Saturday morning, Daniel and the team prayed for an impartation of the Holy Spirit on the thousands of church leaders attending. That evening, he preached: *"In the last 2,000 years, it is the Holy Spirit who has been waiting for you! That's why this is not a "waiting meeting". This is a receiving meeting. Today, the Day of Pentecost has fully come."* With a shout of praise, tens of thousands received the baptism in the Holy Spirit. All over the field, there were moving scenes of tears and worship.

## MY SCARS ARE GONE!

We saw many powerful healing testimonies, like the young man who had a motorbike accident and injured his leg. After the prayer, he unwrapped his bandages, to see that **the massive scar on his foot had disappeared**. On stage, he joyfully showed Daniel the pictures he had on his phone of the injury – now completely healed.



On the first night, Daniel had a word of knowledge for someone with a growth on their neck. He sensed that it was painful and affecting the person's ability to speak. The next night, a lady came forward. She said she had suffered with a painful growth on her throat for years, that made it very difficult to talk. **But during the prayer for the sick, the growth vanished.** With a loud voice, she shouted, "Thank you, Jesus!"

Another beautiful moment was **the testimony of a young man who had lost his voice for the past six years.** His face shining, he leaned into the microphone and loudly sang an acapella solo. The crowd roared and began to sing with him, praising and thanking God.

### WELCOMED AT THE "GATE OF THE CITY"

Ado-Ekiti is a remote place. It's not easy to get to, and not many outsiders go there. After landing in Lagos, we drove for over five hours on the most horrendous roads you can imagine. But as we neared the city, still driving through bush on all sides, we were greeted by a hundred pastors and bishops. **They were waiting on the outskirts at what they call the "Gate of the City" to welcome us**, a tradition of the local Yoruba people. There was loud singing, and dancing, and the rhythmic music of talking drums, which look like hourglasses and make an incredible range of sounds. We stopped and prayed together for God's blessing on the campaign.

The welcome continued as we made our way into the city, many hundreds of people waving and singing alongside the road. **Something touching and unusual were the many motorcyclists wearing jackets and hats they had made from CfaN campaign posters.** It literally took the entire day to make our way to our hotel, such was the level of excitement. After 3 long and weary days of travel, we were ready.

### WALKING MANY HOURS TO HEAR THE WORD

When we publish photos that show the amazing size of the crowd, there is something most people don't realize. **As many as 95% of the people you see have walked to be there. There were around 110,000 people in a single meeting in Ado-Ekiti**, but we counted less than 2,000 vehicles in the parking area. Even with cars bursting with people, that's still only around 12,000 passengers. And there's no public transport at all. In a place as rural as Ado-Ekiti, where the vast majority do not actually stay in the urban area, this means that **people have walked hours, and sometimes days, to attend the meetings.** What a great hunger for God!

On the third day of the campaign, **we received the news that Evangelist Reinhard Bonnke had gone to be with the Lord.** For the entire team, most of whom have been with CfaN for many years, it was a very emotional, difficult day. But there was no doubt for any of us, that precisely on this day, Reinhard would have wanted us to be preaching the Gospel. **On the very day that he went home, tens of thousands gave their lives to Jesus.** It was the largest altar call of the Ado-Ekiti campaign. There could be no greater tribute to a man whose life and ministry were utterly dedicated to bringing the Gospel to African people.

That evening, when Daniel shared the news with the crowd, and showed a brief tribute video on the giant screens, there was a great outpouring of emotion. A loud wave of prayer and praise swept across the crowd, many people weeping where they stood. It went on and on and on, a beautiful and moving expression of love and sorrow. We joined them in celebrating Evangelist Reinhard Bonnke's life of service. As my wife, Evangeline, said to me, *"Today, a giant has marched into Heaven."* **In that moment, we were once again witnesses that the prophecy God gave him so many years ago continues to be fulfilled...**
